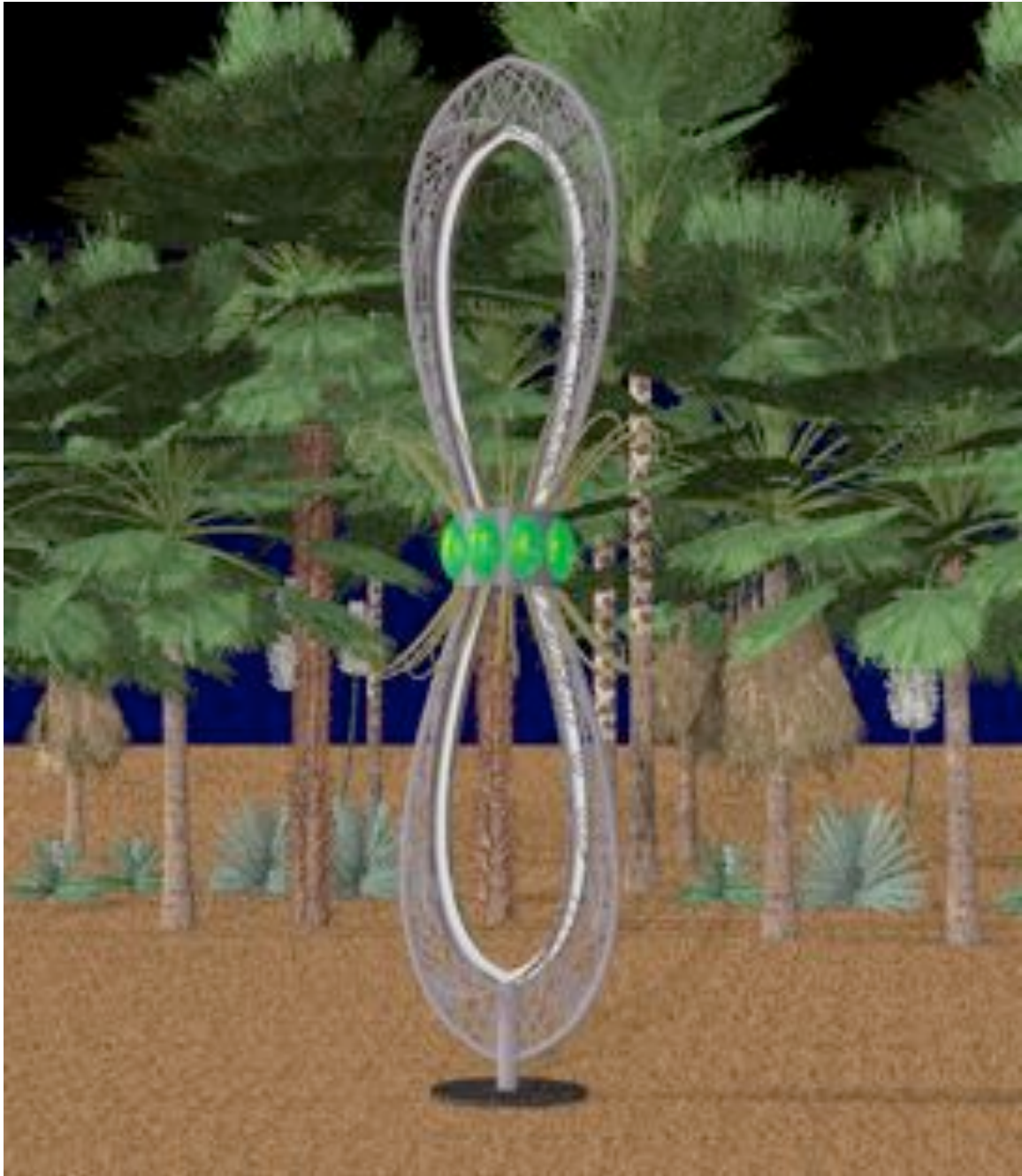

THE DO'S AND DON'TS

Guidelines for Safety and Sanity

1. **DON'T BE DUMB:** This is a basic rule that has a wide variety of practical applications.
2. **NO AMPLIFIED SOUND!!!!:** We are VERY serious about this. The only amplified sound we hear should be coming from the speakers at the stage. This also falls under the authority of RULES 1 and 6.
3. **BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS:** This is an outdoor event that is far removed from.... Well.... Anything. Be sure to be mindful of where you are. There are a lot of uneven surfaces, rocks, holes, and things you would expect to find outdoors.
3. **SAFETY IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY:** While the organizers have taken great steps to ensure the safety of those who attend, we ask that you feel empowered to help keep the event safe. In short... if you see someone breaking RULE #1, don't be afraid to tell them. If you don't feel comfortable telling them, PLEASE tell us.
4. **LEAVE NO TRACE:** As you might expect, this is a LEAVE NO TRACE EVENT. What does that mean? It means that you should plan on hauling out everything that you haul in. This oasis of ours is sacred in its beauty, so please help us keep it that way by not leaving even the slightest scrap of trash or belongings behind.
5. **RESPECT:** To most of us, this goes without saying. Respect your own space and that of others. If you feel that your space is threatened by anyone or anything, PLEASE grab your nearest Ranger or Organizer.
6. **DON'T BE DUMB:** Seriously... we mean it.
7. **PARTY SMART:** Do not engage in activities that put yourself or your fellow attendees at risk... no matter what state you're in.
8. **LISTEN:** The Organizers and Rangers are there to keep things safe and serene for everyone. Please don't argue with them.

RANGERS & MED AREA (GRACELAND)

In honor of our dear friend Ranger Elvis who passed away, there will be a Medical Area/ Ranger HQ located near the Main Stage known as GRACELAND. Rangers will be patrolling the event as well as tending to injuries. Understand that the Rangers are there for your safety and the safety of everyone else. They act with full authority from the organizers. Please respect them as you would us. Bring them treats. They like treats.

GETTING THERE

Travel, Entry, and Camp Placement

When traveling to Fuente Eterno, there are some basic guidelines to follow. Please observe these guidelines to ensure that your trip is as smooth as possible. You are traveling into a different country. The most important rule to follow is: *USE YOUR HEAD.*

VEHICLE

You DO need to have a HIGH CLEARANCE VEHICLE. AGAIN... You DO need to have a vehicle with high clearance. Recent flooding has made the road even more challenging. If you show up in a Civic or a Scion, we take no responsibility when you get yourself stuck. Please refer to rules 1 and 6 for further information....

The last portion of the road is difficult as there are a lot of rocks and boulders to navigate around. Take it nice and slow at the end. We want you to make it in one piece. It's worth it!

CROSS THE BORDER IN MEXICALI

Doing so ensures that you spend the least amount of time actually driving in Mexico, and in our experience, it is the safest and easiest route.

- 1) DO NOT DRIVE LATE AT NIGHT.
- 2) CARAVAN WITH OTHERS AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE
- 3) GATES WILL BE OPEN FROM 10:00am - 11:00pm (coordinate your arrival between these hours)
- 4) YOU need a high clearance vehicle. Does not have to be 4x4**
- 5) No RVs or trailers will be able to pass through
- 6) DO NOT TRAVEL ON THE LAKEBED. THERE IS WATER IN IT. UNLESS YOU ARE DRIVING A BOAT OR AN ARC, YOU WILL HAVE PROBLEMS. INSTEAD, TAKE THE WASHBOARD ROAD THAT IS A LITTLE FURTHER DOWN AND MARKED WITH LARGE ORANGE PILLARS AND SIGNS.
- 7) You MUST Have a PASSPORT. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 8) Narcotics K9 patrols are on BOTH sides of the border crossing.**

DIRECTIONS THROUGH MEXICALI

(US boarder is open 24 hours)

The safest route is through Calexico/Mexicali. The border is open 24 hours a day. Majority of the drive is on the US side, there are no check points and no toll ways. From interstate-5/805 head south and take I-8 east towards El Centro. Take highway 98 towards Calexico and turn right onto highway 111 going west towards the US/Mexico border.

IMPORTANT: After going through the border, stay to your furthest possible right lane when passing through the border crossing, but not the furthest right lane, which is for cars that have to declare valuables.

Once you pass the line. immediately turn right onto the first street. This first street is only 50 feet away from the border passing. **(If you happen to miss it, don't panic keep going and take the next right, which is a one-way street and when you reach the stop sign, make another right and you will be back on track.)**

Follow the road (while it curves slight right) until you pass over a small bridge and keep to your right. After the bridge, go strait for 6 blocks with STOP SIGNS, then turn left on Colegio Militar. You will pass through several STOP signs going strait (A google map to this and also can be printed from <http://www.blueinsomnia.com/mexicali.jpg>) After 2.5 miles, you will reach a round about, continue going strait on the same axis until the road merges with highway 2. Follow on highway 2 going north-west. After 13 miles, you will see the dried lakebed to your left. Follow Highway 2 West to the first "CAÑÓN DE GUADALUPE" junction exit. Turn left onto a graded dirt road. This is the entrance to the western dirt road that leads to Guadalupe Canyon and is recommended for first time visitors. This route is the more "official" road to Guadalupe Canyon, and is slightly higher in elevation, but suffers from some patches of bumpy washboard and sand, and therefore is a little slower than the Dry Lake Route. Nevertheless, this road is generally the safer, surer route if the eastern route is likely to be muddy. If in doubt please call our travel office.

After about 25 miles, another route (Dried Lakebed) merge together from the left, and just continue going strait to the right. At this junction you should see an olive grove to your right. Follow the signs to Canyon De Guadalupe. The last segment of 7 miles begins as a mostly smooth but increasingly winding dirt road. Following this, there is a final half-mile or so of rocky road. SUVs and trucks with good ground clearance are recommended and tend to do best. Go straight and continue on this road.

ENTRY AND PLACEMENT

It is **YOUR** responsibility to arrive when the gates are open. The gates will NOT be staffed 24 hours a day. It is important that we be able to check pay pal receipts, and more importantly, give you your camp placement.

ALL Attendees have been placed into campsites. It is your responsibility to know what camp you are placed in and camp there. You cannot just camp wherever you like as there is a limited capacity in the Canyon and our placements are based on making the environment as comfortable as possible for everyone. The volunteers at the gate will have your placements when you arrive.

GATE HOURS

THURSDAY: - 10AM-11PM

FRIDAY: - 10AM-11PM

SATURDAY: 10AM - 2PM

TIME your arrival to be there when the gate is open. If you have made arrangements to arrive earlier than 10am THURSDAY, you **MUST** check in with an organizer **BEFORE** setting up camp or you risk being relocated.

MEXICO TRAVEL INFO

- 1) Always watch your speed. Remember... Mexican Signs are in Kilometers, not MPH.
- 2) Always be respectful of authorities if you encounter them.
- 3) Be **CERTAIN** that you have Mexican Auto Insurance.

AUTO INSURANCE

Mexican Auto Insurance is mandatory. Google search for Mexican Insurance and you can buy online very cheap. Alternatively, you can purchase Mexican insurance at the border for very cheap. Be sure to read the contract carefully. If you get into an accident, make sure to call the Mexican Insurance before leaving Mexico. The best website is <http://www.mexpro.com/>

PROHIBITED ITEMS

WARNING: Mexican customs prohibits the following items from entering the country in your car. These items will be confiscated if you are caught. There could also be a fine.

Gasoline, Computers (used), Clothing (used), Plants of any type, Rice and Beans, Toilets or bathroom furniture, firearms, ammunition, chemicals, plants, fertilizers, pharmaceuticals

YOU ARE ALLOWED TO BRING A NORMAL AMOUNT OF FOOD OR CLOTHING FOR A NORMAL VACATION.
